Review Summary

- Teachers employ effective teaching strategies in the majority of the lessons and provide a supportive learning environment, particularly in class teaching, Arabic, and mathematics lessons, which contributes to good academic progress among students.
- The school needs to further monitor the effectiveness of the teachers' professional development programmes to enhance the effectiveness of some lessons by utilising learning time, challenging students' abilities, supporting low achieving students, and improving students' English language skills.
