Review Summary

- The school provides an attractive and stimulating learning environment for students, where they receive personal support, demonstrate good behaviour, and engage in diverse extra-curricular activities, events and competitions that cater to their various interests and talents.
- The school's leadership demonstrates a sound understanding of the aspects of schoolwork, actively seeks to involve parents in various school events, and has shown a clear ability to address challenges, such as dealing positively with the steady increase in student numbers.
- Teachers employ effective teaching strategies in the majority of lessons and provide a supportive learning environment, particularly in science and class teacher, contributing to students achieving good academic progress.
- Supporting the low achieving students in lessons and remedial programmes requires further development to ensure the enhancement of their basic skills.
- The school needs to monitor the impact of professional development programmes on the performance of some teachers in Cycle 2, and in English, particularly regarding the use of learning time and the effectiveness of assessment methods in challenging students' abilities during lessons and in written work.
- The school was judged 'Good' when reviewed and will develop an Action Plan based on the review recommendations.
