## Review Summary

- The school offers an appropriate educational environment for learning, where students receive suitable education accompanied by some academic support programmes to develop their basic skills, in addition to the school's clear commitment to providing adequate personal care for students.
- The school has a number of positives, such as its 'one team' ethos, its communication with parents and partners, and its provision of diverse extra-curricular activities that develop students' talents and experiences. Students generally show good behaviour, supported by the school's personal care and guidance.
- The school needs to further focus its efforts on improving educational practices in lessons, in terms of employing effective teaching and learning strategies, activating students' roles, providing clear guidance, utilising learning time and leveraging assessment results to support students, particularly the low-achieving ones.
- The school needs to improve students' skills in core subjects, to prepare them for their transition to Cycle 2 of the primary school.
- Overall, the school is judged 'Satisfactory' when reviewed and will develop an Action Plan based on the review recommendations.
