Review Summary

- Students achieve appropriate standards in core subjects. Internal examinations results are positive over time, though progress in lessons varies between subjects and across different ability groups.
- Students' personal development is good. They are respectful and confident, and many of them take part in school's activities and competitions.
- Support for low achieving students and attendance at remedial sessions need a more systematic, whole-school approach.
- School's leadership has a clear plan towards a full International Baccalaureate (IB) Continuum and receive effective support from the Board of Trustees.
- Students are adequately engaged in lessons, however, the inconsistencies in the use of learning time, the level of challenge and the quality of feedback limit the progress of some of them, particularly in Primary School.
- Arabian Pearl Gulf (APG) School is 'Satisfactory' when reviewed and will draft an Action Plan to sustain its strengths and address the recommendations.
