Review Summary

- The school leadership appropriately manages the aspects of schoolwork in a safe learning environment. It seeks to establish suitable communication channels with parents and partners in the local community; this adequately enhances students' personal and academic experiences.
- Students demonstrate appropriate personal characteristics and are well-behaved. Students with special needs receive effective personal support.
- Students' academic standards and their skills in core subjects require further development, particularly in English language.
- Educational resources and facilities are utilised appropriately. However, teachers' professional development programmes need to be more targeted to ensure the improvement of teaching practices, particularly those related to supporting students of different learning abilities, in and outside lessons, in a way that contributes to raising their academic standards.
- Overall, students receive appropriate personal support at school, and the school will develop an Action Plan based on the recommendations provided in the review report.

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
