### Review Summary

- The school's leadership demonstrates appropriate awareness of all aspects of school operations and consistently seeks to engage parents in school events and activities. Furthermore, it benefits from local community institutions in developing students' diverse talents and experiences.
- The majority of students exhibit good behaviour and participate in various extra-curricular activities confidently. The school provides appropriate personal development programmes to support students, especially those with special needs.
- The school needs to further focus its efforts on supporting students of various educational categories, particularly low achieving ones, students in the learning difficulties programme, and students whose mother tongue is not Arabic, more effectively in lessons and remedial programmes, as well as by developing their basic skills in core subjects.
- The school needs to enhance the effectiveness of teachers' professional development programmes and monitor their impact on classroom performance more closely, particularly those related to implementing more effective teaching strategies, more productive use of learning time, and challenging students' abilities in lessons, assessments, and educational assignments.
- All this indicates that students will continue to progress and develop, while the school will develop an Action Plan based on the recommendations provided in this review report.
