Review Summary

- The school provides a safe and motivating environment for learning, where students receive appropriate education and personal care that supports positive behaviour and reinforces Islamic and national values through school activities and events. Students with special educational needs receive focused attention and effective support.
- The school leadership manages the organisation with appropriate awareness, focusing on development priorities that contribute to improving the school's overall performance. The school also maintains communication with parents and external partners.
- Students make suitable progress in the majority of lessons and learning tasks, with stronger outcomes noted in some Class Teaching lessons. However, the school needs to place greater emphasis on developing students' basic skills in certain lessons in the upper primary stage, particularly in English.
- The school is required to improve the effectiveness of its training programmes and follow up on their impact on classroom performance-specifically by ensuring productive use of learning time, challenging students' abilities, applying more effective assessment strategies, and using results to support students, especially those with low attainment.
- This means that students will continue to receive appropriate education, and the school will develop an Action Plan based on the recommendations provided in the review.
