Main Finding

The British University of Bahrain (BUB) delivers British degrees through a strategic partnership with the University of Salford – Manchester (UoS). During the review, several practices were identified as areas of strength. BUB maintains a strong, quality-focused academic environment supported by its effective partnership with the UoS, enabling high-standard programme development and internationally recognised qualifications. The University provides specialised facilities that enrich students' practical learning, while also fostering supportive academic and personal development for staff. In addition, BUB actively engages industry partners to offer meaningful short-term internships that enhance student employability, ensuring learners gain real-world experience and a seamless transition into their professional careers.

As per the review recommendations, BUB is required to strengthen its strategic and operational management by establishing clear Key Performance Indicators and annual targets across all departments and colleges. BUB should also develop a systematic mechanism for risk identification and mitigation, ensure clear delegation of financial and management authority, and implement a clear mechanism to evaluate the effectiveness of its operations. Additionally, BUB should implement institutional benchmarking regularly, ensure comprehensive occupational health and safety policies, apply mentoring procedures consistently, and implement systematic processes to identify and support students at risk, ensuring effective follow-up and continuous improvement.
