#### Review Summary

- Students are well-behaved, adhere to school rules and regulations, and receive appropriate personal care, reinforced through guidance programmes that support their growth and development. Additionally, they achieve appropriate progress in Arabic and most mathematics lessons.
- The school appropriately seeks to open communication channels with parents and local community institutions, which nurtures students' diverse talents and interests.
- The school needs to exert further efforts to improve students' academic standards and provide effective academic support programmes that ensure their educational needs are addressed, especially for the low achieving ones.
- The school needs to develop its administrative processes, focus on teachers' professional development programmes, and monitor their performance in lessons, particularly in English and science, by employing teaching strategies that align with the educational stage, use effective assessment methods, and productive use of learning time.
- The school's overall effectiveness is judged "Inadequate" with satisfactory features. Therefore, the school should develop an Action Plan based on the review recommendations, and the school will be scheduled for a monitoring visit.
