Review Summary

- The majority of students at the school are well-behaved, adhere to national and Islamic values, and participate in sports activities in which they have achieved advanced rankings. This has fostered their sense of belonging and stability within the school environment.
- The school benefits from its community partnerships and appropriate communication with parents in supporting student behaviour and developing their interests and talents.
- The school needs to improve its operational plan by adopting accurate self-evaluation, utilising its results to identify improvement priorities, and enhancing implementation and follow-up mechanisms to ensure progress in all aspects of school operations.
- The school needs to provide targeted, regular academic support programmes for all diverse categories of students, while monitoring the quality of their implementation, and offer effective support in lessons to help improve achievement and mastery of basic skills, alongside enhancing the quality of school-based assessments.
- The school should enhance teaching practices by aligning professional development with teachers' actual needs, focusing on effective strategies, optimal use of learning time, assessment aligned with curriculum competencies, and support for low-achieving students, while also strengthening students' personal development, particularly in the Intermediate stage.
- The school's overall effectiveness was rated "Inadequate". The school will develop an Action Plan based on the recommendations provided by the review team and will be scheduled for a monitoring visit.
