Sufficient Progress

- The school has successfully made sufficient improvements to its overall performance and addressed all the recommendations from the previous review, particularly those related to the effectiveness of teaching practices in the majority of lessons, the development of students' basic skills, their written work, and school programmes.
- The school leadership identified its development priorities and restructured its plans with clear action steps, systematically monitoring their implementation through organised and varied mechanisms. The school also focused on training teachers and regularly following up on their classroom performance, which contributed to improved teaching effectiveness in the majority of lessons.
- The school placed strong emphasis on improving students' academic achievement by delivering a range of programmes tailored to different student groups, which has led to adequate improvement in their performance across the majority of lessons.
- The school should continue to enhance learning processes and further develop students' basic skills, particularly in English. It should also maintain academic support for students across all learning categories.
- The school is expected to continue its improvement efforts and will be scheduled for a regular review during the next visit.
