- Modern Knowledge Schools offer a good teaching and learning experience to its students.
- School leadership is strategic and resilient, with a clear understanding of priorities and a structured approach to improvement based on thorough self-evaluation.
- Positive behaviour is well promoted, using restorative discipline and multi-tiered personal support systems that cater to students' needs.
- Students generally achieve high standards, and their progress is evident in the majority of lessons, with the need for further improvement in Arabic skills, particularly writing.
- Student-centred teaching approaches and effective use of digital tools are adopted in the majority of lessons.
- Further focus on differentiation is needed to ensure better challenge and support to students of all abilities.
- Academic support programmes are effective in Elementary School, which is yet to be extended across the schools to better support students, particularly the low-achieving ones.
