Review Summary

- Uqba Bin Nafe'a Primary Boys School provides a stimulating learning environment where students demonstrate self-discipline and exemplary behaviour, show respect towards their peers and teachers, and actively engage in diverse programmes and activities.
- Students achieve appropriate progress in most lessons and written work, with notably better progress in the majority of Classroom Teaching lessons, resulting from teachers' implementation of positive teaching strategies and learning resources.
- The school seeks to provide continuous professional development programmes for its teachers through targeted training programmes and motivates them while implementing effective projects, contributing to their enhanced performance in lessons.
- The school should continue its efforts to improve students' standards, particularly in Cycle 2 and in English, by providing more regular and effective academic support programmes, especially for the low-achieving students.
- The school needs to further improve its teaching practices in lessons by monitoring the impact of professional development programmes on teachers to ensure overall school's improvement.
- All the above indicates that students are receiving appropriate education and effective personal care. The school will develop an Action Plan based on the review recommendations.
