### Review Summary

- The school should improve the effectiveness of teaching practices by implementing effective teaching strategies, maximising learning time, and adopting effective assessment methods aligned with curriculum competencies. Furthermore, the school should utilise their results to improve students' performance, particularly the low achievers.
- The school needs to conduct a more accurate evaluation of its educational reality and develop plans according to its specific priorities, with follow-up on their implementation to improve learning processes and raise students' academic achievement standards.
