Review Summary

- The school provides a positive and stimulating learning environment, where students are well-behaved with high self-confidence, and a clear ability to assume leadership roles, which is positively reflected in students' level of participation in their learning. Additionally, the school provides students with good personal care and wellbeing.
- The school's leadership demonstrates a clear ability to administer the schoolwork through effective institutional practices. Furthermore, it encourages development opportunities and innovation with support from the school community and partners.
- The effectiveness of support programmes provided for the more-able students and students with learning difficulties, along with the employment of diverse and effective teaching strategies in the majority of lessons, contributed to enhancing students' learning and achieving positive academic progress, especially in English and most Class Teaching lessons.
- The school needs to intensify its efforts in developing students' basic skills and enhancing the level of challenge in lessons and school programmes to address their diverse needs, particularly for low achieving ones.
- The school needs to further improve teaching practices, especially in science and Arabic by following up on the impact of professional development programmes on the performance of some teachers.
- The school is judged as "Good" when reviewed and will develop an action plan based on the review recommendations.

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
