Review Summary

- Pulse Health Training Center (PHTC) employs qualified and experienced trainers who effectively integrate theoretical knowledge with practical application within a supportive learning environment.
- The Centre demonstrates appropriate sector awareness and commitment to aligning its provision with healthcare regulatory requirements.
- Learners acquire relevant knowledge, skills, and competencies in healthcare practice, and the majority achieve their targeted certifications and become eligible to apply for professional privileges.
- To further improve provision, PHTC should enhance learners' practical competency development.
- The Centre needs to strengthen the rigour and consistency of assessment verification and moderation processes, with the provision of written feedback.
- Admission arrangements and access to programme information should be improved to ensure appropriate learner placement.
- The use of data analysis and quality assurance processes should be enhanced to better inform decision-making and support continuous improvement.
- PHTC is rated 'Satisfactory' overall and will develop an Action Plan to address the review recommendations and improve performance.

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
