Review Summary

- Students are well behaved, demonstrating self-discipline and respect for their teachers and peers within a nurturing learning environment that provides appropriate personal care and support.
- School leadership demonstrates an appropriate awareness of the school's improvement priorities, alongside maintaining adequate communication with stakeholders to enrich students' personal development and learning experiences.
- Students make adequate progress in most lessons and in written work. However, further efforts are needed to improve students' basic skills in core subjects and to provide more targeted academic support programmes that meet their learning needs, particularly for low-achieving students.
- The school needs to improve the effectiveness of teachers' professional development programmes, to further target their needs, with stronger follow-up on their impact in classroom practices, aiming to improve overall teaching and learning provision.
- The school's overall effectiveness is "Satisfactory". An action plan will be developed based on the recommendations of the review.

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
