Review Summary

- Students demonstrate good behaviour, showing appropriate self-discipline and respect towards their teachers and peers. They also take responsibility in school life, supported by the effectiveness of positive behaviour programmes such as the "With My Behaviour I Improve" initiative, student committees such as the "School Broadcasting Committee," and the appropriate personal care provided to them.
- School leadership implements organisational and administrative measures to support the smooth running of school operations, while benefiting from the appropriate involvement of parents and partners in strengthening these efforts.
- The school needs to focus its efforts on priorities related to raising academic achievement and strengthening students' acquisition of basic skills, particularly in English and mathematics.
- The school should improve teachers' performance in lessons, particularly in developing assessment methods and feedback, making efficient use of learning time, and ensuring that students' abilities are challenged and supported academically, especially low-achieving students.
- The school's overall effectiveness was judged 'Inadequate with Satisfactory Features'. The school should therefore develop an Action Plan based on the review recommendations, and a monitoring visit will be scheduled.
